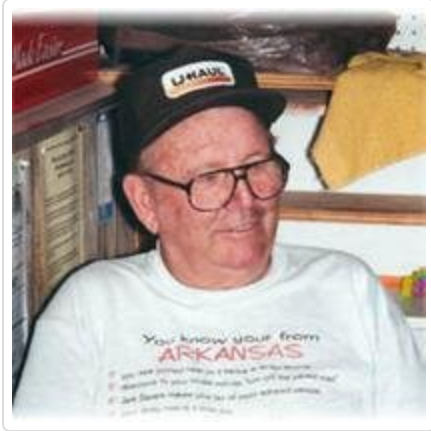




## Glenmore Smith
