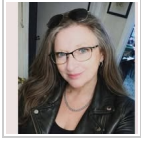

Memorial contributions can be made in Judy's memory to SPCA or Alzheimer's Association.

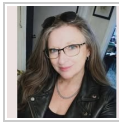

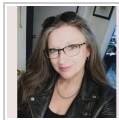
