Paul served a four year service in the United Air Force from 1954-1958. He later went on to the Dallas School of Mortuary Science where he received his license as a funeral director and embalmer. He worked in the funeral industry for six years before opening his own business. Prior to retirement, Paul owned and operated, Paul Newborn Transport. Paul loved working on his farm and riding his tractor. He loved going to the Rock Café downtown and drinking coffee with everyone. Paul was notorious for wearing his cowboy hat everywhere he went. For the last six months, Paul had residence at Shiloh Nursing Center where he was lovingly, and fittingly, referred to as “cowboy.” Paul loved his family and especially enjoyed and treasured those grandkids. On September 20, 2013, Paul and his bride would have celebrated their 54 year anniversary.

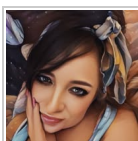
