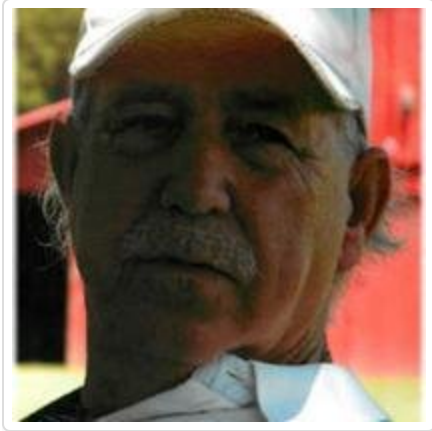




Robert Brown
