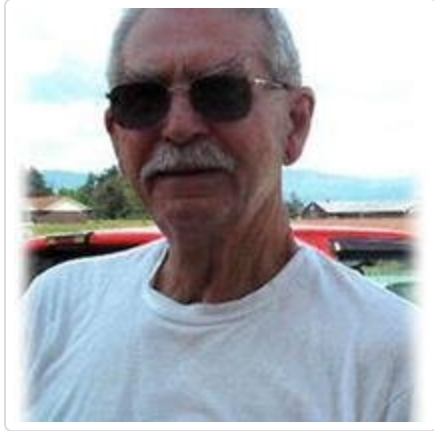




Samuel Simpson

Samuel Chester Simpson, Jr. , 83, of Waldron, Arkansas passed from this life Monday, May 24, 2010 in a Waldron, Arkansas nursing home.
